Wet-formed Handbag

If you're willing to invest time and patience into this project, you'll be rewarded with a one-of-a-kind handbag. This advanced project revolves around wet shaping techniques, requiring 2 days to complete due to necessary drying times. However, the actual hands-on crafting time totals only 4-6 hours. It's a perfect opportunity to immerse yourself in craftsmanship and create something truly exceptional

This Pattern is A3 size

Necessary tools and materials for this project:

utility knife, rotary cutter, scissors, edge creaser, hole puncher set, ruler, stitching hole puncher prongs, needles, lighter, sandpaper, wooden form and edge slicker

The thread we use is 0.4mm for o-rings and 0.8mm wax thread for main piece

The leather we use is veg tan cowhide 3mm-3.5mm thick and for the o rings 2mm thick.

Shoulder straps 20mm/110cm long with clasp at one end, and 20mm/40cm long with clasp at one end and buckle on the other.
